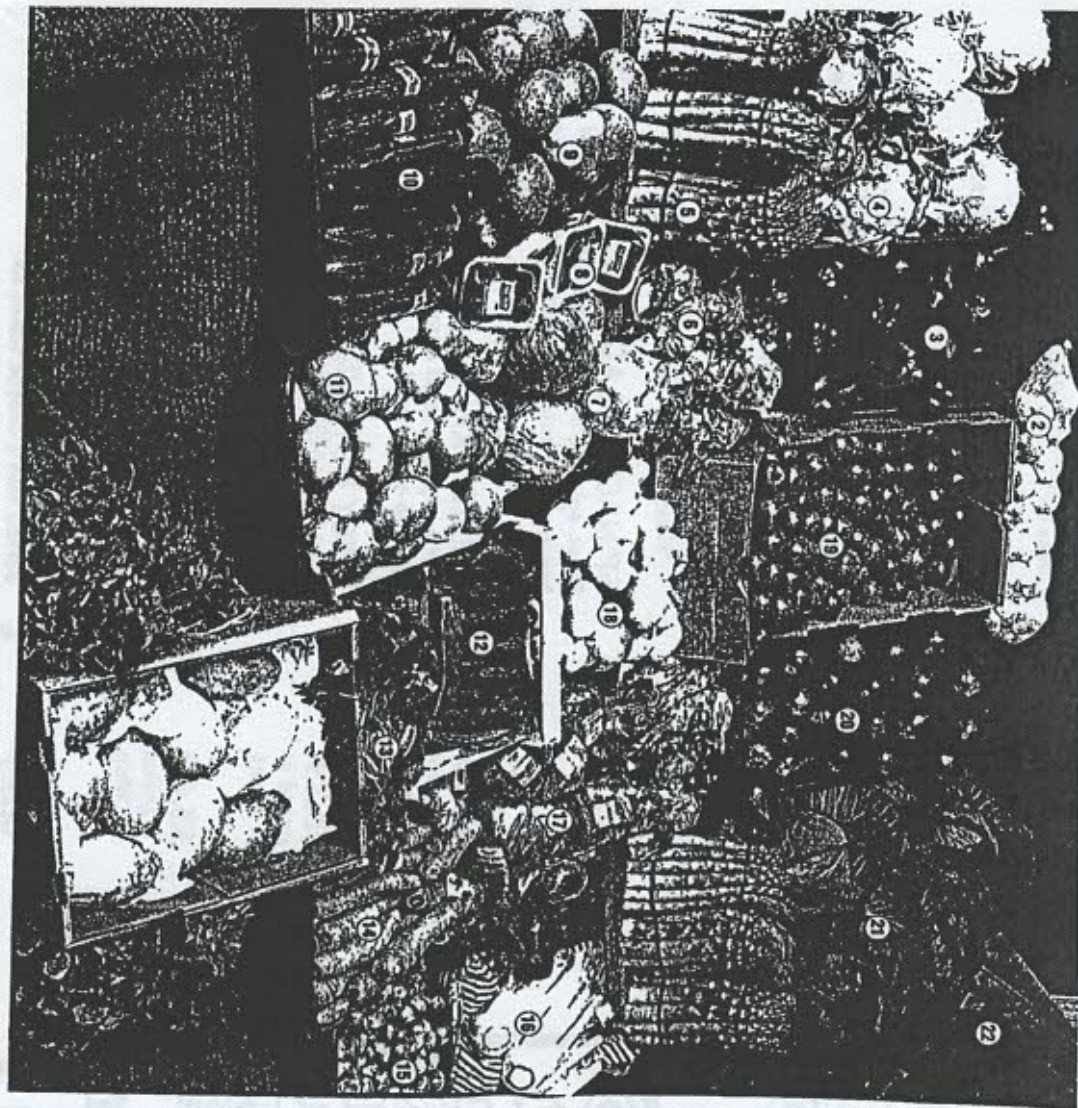

## 12. SHOPPING

When we go shopping (or do shopping or go to the shops), we can go either to a big department store or to the shop which specializes in some extra goods, e.g. the greengrocer specializes in fruit and vegetables, the butcher in meat, the baker in bread and cakes, the tobacconist in cigarettes and tobacco, the confectioner or sweet shop in sweet and ice-cream, the fishmonger in fish, the florist in flowers, the newsagent in newspapers and magazines, the men's wear and women's wear in clothes and dresses, the lingerie in underwear, the draper in cloths and bed-clothes, the wine-merchant in alcoholic drinks of all kinds, the ironmonger in metal goods (tools, pots, pans, nails etc.), the dairy sells milk products and eggs, the stationary sells paper products and office supplies, the jeweller sells jewellery, the toyshop sells various toys for children (dolls, teddies), the delicatessen sells some exclusive and more expensive food, the electrical appliances shop sells TV and radio sets, fridges etc. The most common shop in Britain is the grocer's.
